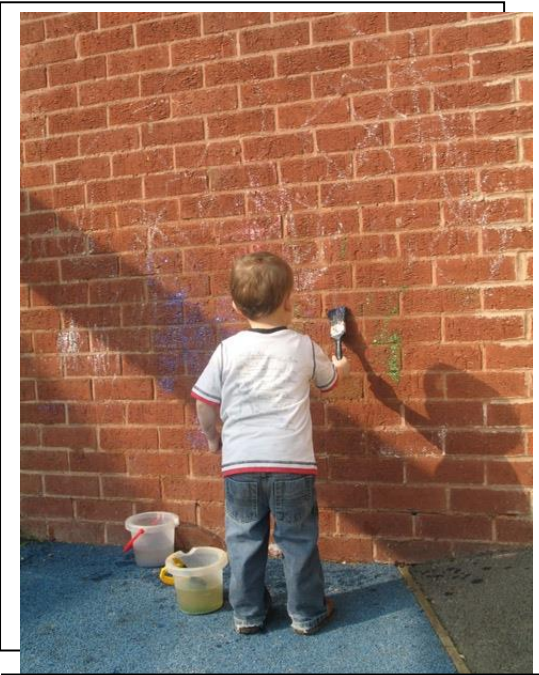
# It's fun to play outdoors

### Activities you can try:

- Draw with sticks in the mud.
- Water in a small bucket with brushes to paint the walls and floors

- Bottles or spray bottles with water.
- Collect natural objects such as grass, leaves, flowers to make sticky pictures.
- Make petal potions with petals and water.
- Welly printing.
